About Conference

The growing vulnerabilities of cyberspace have been recognized as a threat to national security. Consequently, study and research on various aspects of cyber security has become one of the major strategic agenda for the Government, stakeholders (practitioners), academic universities/institutions, research think tanks, and private organizations. The discourse on cyber affairs has continuously been evolving with expansion in cyber domain, development of ICT technologies and infrastructure, multiple perspectives related to technical, legal, governance and security aspects, which continues to evolve and keep influencing various nations or organizations to introduce new policies over it. As a result, challenges to protect the cyber domain become more complex and advanced. The advent/introduction of cutting-edge technologies such as Artificial Intelligence (AI), Internet of Things (IoT) Big Data and Quantum Computing (which otherwise were not vividly discussed or existed earlier during the time of forming the first cyber security policy) has now forced the present security policy to be amended or changed accordingly. Hence, new apposite guidelines are required to be implemented considering the technological insecurity, civil defense, military domain, and criminal activities affiliated with digital ecosystem (network).

Concerning the growing vulnerabilities of cyberspace and emerging challenges of exponential increment for internet connecting devices, the School of National Security Studies (SNSS), CUG along with the Directorate of Research & Publication, RRU is organizing a two-day online national conference on "National Security and Cyberspace: Issues and Challenges". This conference would focus on national security and its connections with cyber related research/study, technologies, social media, crime, darknet, warfare, policy, law, security, strategies, critical infrastructure, AI, IoT and Big Data.
